Practice additional problems and ask for clarification on concepts you find challenging. Are FLVS Geometry DBA answers different for each student? Yes, DBAs are typically customized or generated to ensure

academic integrity. Sharing or requesting specific answers can violate policies, so focus on understanding the material to succeed honestly.

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
